

## WELCOME TO FAMILY CAMP!

We are so happy you have joined us at Family Camp! Here are a few things you should know while you are here. All hosted activities start at the main Parkway Tent. Head over to get more details, sign up for activities, discover impromptu activities, games and more!

**HIKING:** Friday, at 10am. It's a fairly easy 2 mile roundtrip hike. More avid hikers will venture to the bottom of the falls but the path is steep and often slippery. Good hiking shoes are recommended and they may/will get dirty (flip flops are not recommended). Bring water!

- Where: Mill & Barr Creek Falls Trailhead 1067 Mill Creek Dr. #1001, Prospect, OR 97536
- **Directions:** (9 min by car) Head north on OR-62E towards Prospect (7.3 miles). Turn right on Prospect Access Rd (0.3 miles). Turn left onto Mill Creek Dr (0.6 miles). Arrive at trailhead.

**GLOW PARADE:** To participate in the Glow Parade, gather at 7pm by the main tent, we will be providing glow sticks to decorate your ride. For those watching the parade from your campsite, we will be handing out glowsticks for you to light our path. You can wave them, tie them to your camp post, decorate your beard, and/or cheer on the riders as they ride laps around B-Loop.

**DECORATE YOUR CAMPSITE:** To enter this competition, just decorate your campsite! This year's theme is Gilligan's Island. You'll be competing for one of three trophies: Peoples Choice, Decorations Overboard and Tropical Paradise.

**CARDBOARD REGATTA:** Set sail in your very own cardboard vessel! Design, build, and pilot a team-built cardboard boat competing for Fastest Time, Most Glorious Sinking, and Best Design. Teams of two or more will be supplied with materials, given 1 hour to construct their boat, then race head-to-head for glory. Sign up at the main tent to be one of the 10 teams to compete Saturday morning at 10 am. Each team will need 2 life vests (to be worn by "captain" and "crew").

**BOATING:** We've rented a pontoon boat Fri & Sat. Don't worry, we have an experienced captain, and you will return from your free, 1-hour tour! Sign up for the pontoon at the main tent and meet at the bottom of the boat ramp at your designated time.

Also available at the swim area will be a Ski Boat and Jet Ski. Meet at the swim area during boating and swimming times to go for a ride!

**PARKING:** Only one vehicle per camp site, please don't park on the grass. Parking is only allowed in designated spaces. If you have a second vehicle, you will need to park outside of B Loop for an additional fee (see campground host to pay fee).

When going to the swimming area (day use area), be sure to bring your parking pass (located at your camp post), otherwise you will have to pay the day use fee.
